

Faculty Specialist II-Lecturer - Intercultural and Anthropological Studies

Major Duties

- Teach 12 credit hours of courses in forensic anthropology, bioarcheology, museum studies, and/or biological anthropology per semester, including required and/or elective courses for students in anthropology programs and WMU Essential Studies courses.
- Assist unit with curriculum and course development within the anthropology program.
- Contribute toward Institute activities such as student recruitment and advising, as well as organizing extra-curricular programming relevant to the program (e.g. inviting outside speakers, collaborating with the community).
- Contribute service to promote gender and diversity equity in STEM fields.
- Other duties and service as assigned by the unit's director.
- Scholarship activity that informs and complements teaching is desirable, but not required.

Minimum Qualifications

- PhD in anthropology or a related field.
- Minimum of 5 years teaching experience at the college level as the instructor of record.
- Demonstrated ability to teach one or more of the following courses:
 - Biological Anthropology; Race, Biology and Culture; Forensic Anthropology; World Cultures: Asia.
 - Human Evolution; Paleopathology, Bioarcheology, Death and Mortuary Ritual.
 - Funerary Archaeology, Primate Behavior and Ecology, and/or Quantitative Methods in.
 - Anthropology and Archaeology.

Desired Qualifications

- Scholarship and teaching expertise in one or more of the following areas:
 - Bioarcheology; Archaeological Field Excavation; Diet, Health and Mobility; Human-Environment Interactions and Adaptation; Age, Gender, and Caregiving; Mortuary Rites and Funerary Archaeology; Human Osteology; Forensic Anthropology; Museum Collection Management and Curation.
- Experience promoting gender and diversity equity in STEM fields.
- Experience with outreach in K-12 school environments.
