

## Assistant Professor

The Departments of Geography and Anthropology (G&A) and African and African American Studies (AAAS) at Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge invite applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Human Geography to begin fall 2023. A PhD degree or its equivalent in Geography or a related field such as Ethnic Studies is required at the time of appointment. The appointment will be full-time (nine-month) with a 2-2 teaching load. The position is a joint hire between the departments of G&A (51%) and AAAS (49%), both in the College of the Humanities and Social Sciences.

We seek applicants who will complement current faculty research and teaching on environmental issues and race as they pertain to the university's emphasis on coast, energy, and/or agriculture and can contribute to our new and growing Concentration in Environmental Studies and to the newly formed Department of African and African American Studies. The position should be particularly attractive to those doing research on climate justice, environmental racism, Black political ecologies, and similar topics, especially in the Gulf Coast region.

Candidates should have a promising program of research, publication, and extramural funding. Expectations are to teach and advise graduate and undergraduate students. The two departments offer BA, BS, MS, and PhD degrees in Geography; BA, MA, and PhD degrees in Anthropology; and a BA degree and graduate minor in African and African American Studies. At the undergraduate level, we are looking for a colleague to teach World Regional Geography and courses in the Environmental Studies Concentration, preferably cross listed with African and African American Studies courses. Human geographers have found ample opportunities to collaborate with cultural anthropologists and other members of the department and university. Faculty in the department also contribute to interdepartmental programs in Coastal Studies, International Studies, and Women's, Gender and Sexuality Studies.

We welcome applicants who bring additional dimensions of diversity to our program.
