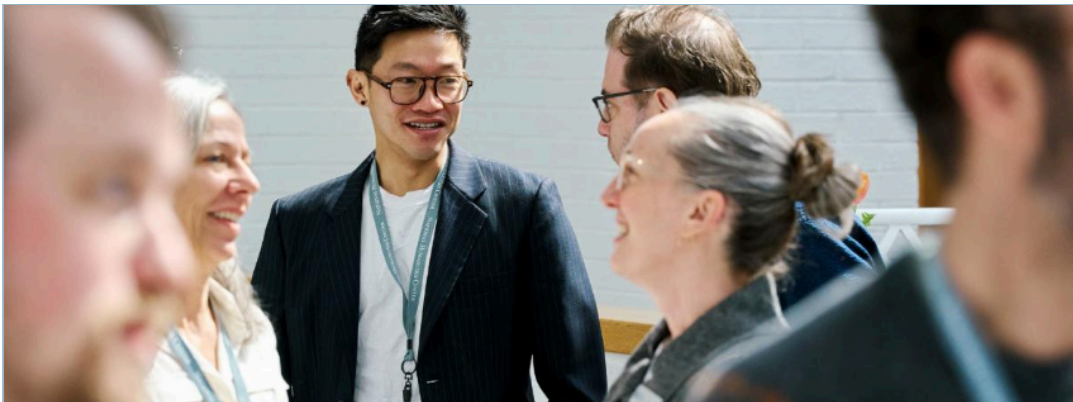




National Humanities Center Residential Fellowships 2027–28 | Call for Applications
